Title of the Workshop: Workshop on Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Power Generation

In this workshop, Dr. Ashok Jadhwar, New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Ahmednagar, guided the students on the topic of "Solar Thermal Power Generation" and also gave in-depth information about how solar heaters, solar cookers, solar dryers work and their various types. . Information was given on how using solar thermal power can produce potable water even in the sea.

The second lecture in this workshop was Dr. Ravikiran Late, Ahmednagar College, Ahmednagar delivered on "Solar Photovoltaic Power Generation". Information about how electricity can be generated using solar energy.
