स्पर्धेत द्वितीय क्रमांक पटकावित १ लाख रुपयाचे रोख पारितोषिक व ट्रॉफी मिळविले. आक्हाड याने या स्पर्धेत महाराष्ट्र राज्यात पहिला येण्याचा मान पटकावला. त्याने मिळविलेल्या या यशामुळे तालुक्याच्या शिरपेचात मानाचा तुरा खोवला आहे. आंतरराष्ट्रीय खुल्या बुद्धिबळ स्पर्धा दि. २३ ते २६ जानेवारीदरम्यान बंगळूरु येथे पार पडल्या. स्पर्धेसाठी २० देशांतून सुमारे ७५२ स्पर्धक सहभागी झाले होते. स्पर्धेसाठी तीन पारितोषिके ठेवण्यात आली होती. त्यामध्ये आक्हाड याने द्वितीय क्रमांक मिळविला. बंगळूरु येथे कर्नाटकचे मुख्यमंत्री सिद्धरामय्या यांच्या हस्ते त्याला रोख एक लाखाचे पारितोषिक देऊन गौरवण्यात आले. यावेळी उपमुख्यमंत्री डी. के.

शिवकुमार उपस्थित होते. यापूर्वी प्रज्वल आक्हाड याने सावित्रीबाई फुले पुणे विद्यापीठ, आंतर विद्यापीठ स्पर्धा तसेच ऑल इंडिया बुद्धिबळ स्पर्धेत प्रथम क्रमांक मिळविलेला आहे. आक्हाड याचे बुद्धिबळमधील आंतरराष्ट्रीय रेटिंग १ हजार ५८८ आहे. आक्हाड याची परिस्थिती अत्यंत सामान्य असल्याने तो आपल्या घरीच बुद्धिबळ या खेळाचा दररोज दहा तास करीत आहे. बुद्धिबळाच्या स्पर्धा कुठे असल्या तरी त्या स्पर्धेसाठी श्री तिलोक जैन ज्ञान प्रसारक मंडळ ही संस्था त्याला साहाय्य करीत असून, संस्थेने त्याला दत्तक घेतलेले आहे.

Twelve (12) students were participated.

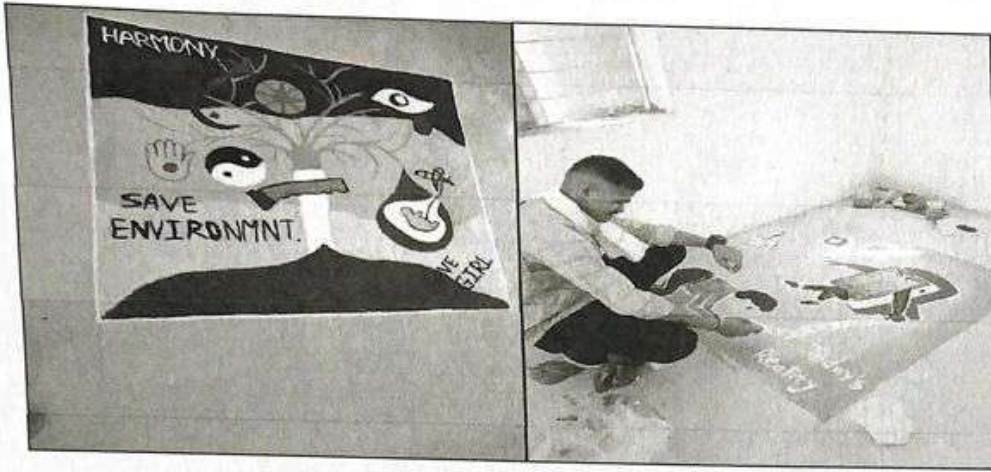



Your sentence stress and use of pauses will make your messages precise and powerful.

Elocution lessons will help you if you are worried your voice is too quiet and people ask to repeat what you said often because they cannot hear you. Your posture will be straight. The basis of breath is posture. Here is the basic thing to check to improve your posture. Stand in a well centered position with feet firmly on the floor, slightly apart, relaxing the knees and hips, and keeping the shoulders down, free from any tension. Feel your spine straightening with your head balanced on the neck, as if it was attached to the ceiling by a piece of elastic coming from the top of it.

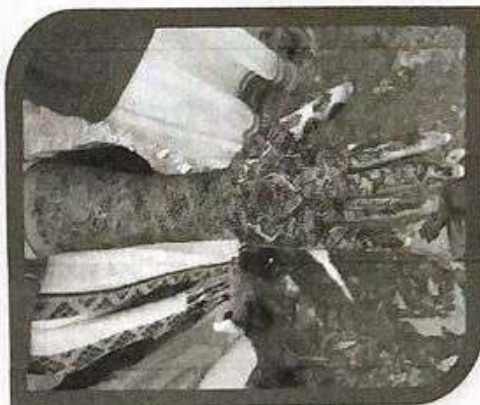
